We aim to confirm all childcare places by the end of the day ready for those who are eligible to come to school for childcare tomorrow.

Vulnerable Childcare

Any children who are identified as vulnerable as defined in the DfE guidance will be offered a childcare place at St Ann's. We will be contacting all parents directly if your child is eligible.
