

YEAR ONE

 Number: Addition and subtraction within 20, drawing attention to strategies (e.g. Make 10, counting on) and structures (e.g. first, then, now', combining or partitioning sets, finding difference). Partitioning 2-digit numbers into tens and ones Exploring repeated addition and the part-whole model and how it links with multiplication and division <u>Shape and Pattern:</u> Use mathematical language to describe size and position using vocabulary whole, half, quarter, three quarter turns, clockwise and anti-clockwise Identify and describe 2-D and 3-D shapes using vocabulary side, edge, face and vertices

Maths Lessons

Reception will focus on

Number patterns within 15 – Count up 15 objects and recognise different representations

Order and explore number patterns to 15 one more one fewer

Doubling and halving – the relationship between doubling and halving

Number patterns within 20 - count up to 10 and beyond with objects

Represent compare and explore numbers to 20 - One more one fewer

Securing addition and subtraction facts – commutatively explore addition and subtraction compare two amounts

Year One will focus on

Addition and subtraction within 20 comparison and difference

represent and use number bonds and related facts within 20

Add and subtract one-digit numbers to 20 including zero

Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition, subtraction and equal to signs

Solve one step problems that involve addition and subtraction using concrete objects and pictorial representations and missing problems

Fractions

recognise find and name half as one of two equal parts of an object shape or quantity recognise find and name a quarter as one of four equal parts of an object shape quantity

Multiplication and Division

Solve one step problems involving multiplication and division by calculating the answer using concrete objects pictorial representations and arrays with the support of the teacher

Count in multiples of twos fives and tens

Writing

This term we will be writing for a range of different purposes carefully considering the needs of the audience.

The children will be using the story of 'Where's my teddy' and the 'three little pigs' to write a narrative focusing on simple sentence structures using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. The children will continue to develop their handwriting skills and will be encouraged to proof read and edit their work and be encouraged to share their work in front of other children. In phonics the children will continue
