English:

This half term we will be looking at writing a balanced debate. The children will identify many grammatical features, including persuasive techniques such as rhetorical questions and precise conjunctions. They will also be writing sentences that include adjectives, conjunctions and complex sentence structures. They will identify different word types including modal verbs, conjunctions, contractions, pronouns and prepositions, whilst continuing to improve their ability to punctuate and edit their own writing.

Later in the term, children will continue to focus on non-fiction writing, and using their knowledge of adjectives, adverbs, formal language and complex punctuation to create a non-chronological report on *The Origin of Species*. We also be looking at beginning to refine the skills needed to write formally-revisiting using complex structures such as passive and active voice and the subjunctive form.

Spelling and Handwriting

We will be working on children's handwriting and spelling each week.

After half term, children will be given weekly spelling words each Thursday, to practice at home, which will be tested weekly.

Maths Meetings

Maths meetings will cover multiplication and division of numbers up to one million, fractions, decimals and percentages, angles and coordinates.

<u>Maths Lessons</u>

Maths lessons this term will include in depth teaching on division with numbers up to 6 digits. Later in the term we will focus our learning on calculation problems, fractions, percentages and decimals and measurement.



Reading- Our class novel is *Holes and the Philosopher's Stone* by Louis Sachar.

We expect children to read for 5-10 minutes each day, practice is the only way to improve fluency of word reading.
